Bayonets and Barbed Wire is the History of the 16th Battalion in World War 1, from its formation in Australia in 1914 and its service in Egypt, Gallipoli and the Western Front. Bayonets and Barbed Wire is a hard covered, 702-page, B5 volume, containing 711 photographs and 18 maps, as well as hundreds of eye-witness reports from contemporary diaries, letters, reports and journals of 16th Battalion men.
